



REGULATIONS FOR THE PYRENEES NO LIMITS CHALLENGE 2026

1. Introduction

- 1.1. PYRENEES NO LIMITS** is a challenge created to bring together the three most beautiful cycling sportives in our Pyrenees. In France, Spain, and Andorra, the three events cover the emblematic passes of the Pyrenees.
- 1.2. PYRENEES NO LIMITS** is co-organized by the organizers of the cycling sportives Quebrantahuesos Gran Fondo, L'Ariégeoise, and the 3 Naciones.
- 1.3. 1.3. PYRENEES NO LIMITS** includes registration and participation in the three events on the following dates and locations:

3 Naciones	6 of june of 2026	Puigcerdà (Girona)
Quebrantahuesos	20 of june of 2026	Sabiñàigo (Huesca)
L'Ariégeoise	27 of june of 2026	Tarascon-sur-Ariège

- 1.4.** It is not possible to register for only one or two of the events.
- 1.5.** This challenge adheres to the specific regulations of each evento, written according to the [UCI Cycling Regulations: Cycling for All](#), all of the Union Cycliste Internationale.

2. Registration

- 2.1.** Anyone wishing to participate in this challenge must register through the [plataforma oficial](#). To validate the registration, all required information in the form must be completed and the registration fee must be paid.
- 2.2.** Registration closes on Wednesday, April 22, 2026 at 13:00 (Spanish peninsular time) or once the 60 available slots are filled.
- 2.3.** The registration fee per participant is €269.
- 2.4.** Registration includes:
- Online and in-person participant support.
 - Right to participate in the 3 cycling sportives.
 - Accident insurance for cyclists who indicate they are not licensed.
 - Commemorative jersey for those who finish the PNL 2026 challenge.
 - Participation diploma for those who finish the PNL 2026 challenge.



- Additional benefits for each specific evento:
 - Number plate and bibs.
 - Stickers with stage profiles.
 - Race Pack.
 - Finisher gift (if applicable).
 - Timing and live tracking.
 - Electronic device for time control.
 - Route marking and staff.
 - Sweeper vehicles.
 - Liquid and solid feed zones.
 - Medical assistance.
 - Mechanical assistance during the race.
 - Bicycle washing service.
 - Supervised bicycle parking.
 - Cloakroom.
 - Changing rooms, toilets, and showers.
- 2.5.** The registration fee is not refunded if the participant is disqualified or withdraws from any of the events.
- 2.6.** Registration for the challenge is considered final. If the registered participant cannot or does not wish to participate after completing the registration, the fee will not be refunded. Registrations are strictly personal and non-transferable and cannot be used by anyone other than the registered participant. Substituting a participant or transferring a registration to future editions is not permitted.

3. Participants

- 3.1.** All participants must be at least 18 years old on the day of the first event of the challenge (3 Nacions, June 6, 2026).
- 3.2.** The bib number will be assigned by each specific event.
- 3.3.** There will be no overall classification for those registered in this challenge.
- 3.4.** Cyclists who complete the full route of all three events will be considered “Finishers” of the Pyrenees No Limits 2026 challenge.
- 3.5.** Cyclists will not be considered “Finishers” if they:
 - Do not finish any of the events (resulting in DNF / Disqualified).
 - Do not comply with the time limits set by the road closure deadlines.



- Do not start any of the events (DNS).
- Do not collect their bib for any of the events.

4. Rewards

- 4.1. Once the “No Limits Pyrenees” challenge is completed and achieved, each participant will receive an exclusive jersey sent to the postal address provided during registration as a reward for successfully completing the challenge.
- 4.2. Additionally, all participants in the three events will receive a certificate acknowledging their participation in the challenge.
- 4.3. Participation in the “No Limits Pyrenees” challenge grants direct entry to the next edition of the Quebrantahuesos without having to enter the lottery.

5. Considerations

- 5.1. The cyclist registered for the challenge accepts these regulations.
